

The goal of this year's Summer Reading challenge is to encourage children of the Groves community to read or listen to books during the summer so they can maintain and improve good reading skills.

Sign up begins June 2nd, 2022 from 3 PM to 7 PM at the library. First log is due June 10th, 2022

Reading logs are to be turned in every Friday

Deadline for the last reading log will be July 22nd, 2022

Awards given July 29th, 2022

There are five reading divisions:

Read to Me (any age to Pre-K) Kindergarten – 1^{st} grade 2^{nd} - 3^{rd} grade 4^{th} and 5^{th} grade Teen reading is for children 13 and up

Themed book bags will be given to the first 200 children who sign up June 2nd, between 3 PM and 7 PM.

Record each book read appropriately on your reading log - one book per line. Library staff will record your books read each week. Do not call or email the library to add titles.

There will be prizes given to all participants who return their reading logs.

Those who read the following amounts will have their names put into a drawing for a prize:

Read to Me (any age to Pre-K) and Kindergarten -1^{st} grade AT LEAST ten (10) books Grades 2^{nd} - 3^{rd} grade and 4^{th} and 5^{th} grade AT LEAST five (5) books Teens AT LEAST two (2) books

Reading logs must be turned in on Friday to count for weekly drawings!

Awards will be given to the top three readers of each category July 29th. Parents will be contacted.
