

The goal of this year's Summer Reading challenge is to encourage children of the Groves community to read or listen to books during the summer so they can maintain and improve good reading skills.

Sign up begins June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 from 3 PM to 7 PM at the library. First log is due June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Reading logs are to be turned in every Friday Deadline for the last reading log will be July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Awards given August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 <u>There are four reading divisions:</u> Read to me (any age to Pre-K) Kindergarten – 1<sup>st</sup> grade 2<sup>nd</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade Teen reading is for children 12 and up

Treats will be given to the children who sign up between 3 PM and 7 PM in the library. Reading bags will also be given as the parent registers their child/children.

Record each book read appropriately on your reading log - one book per line. Library staff will record your books read each week. Do not call or email the library to add titles.

T-shirts will be given to all participating children and teens after the start of the Summer Reading Program.

There will be a small prize given to children who return their reading logs on Friday. Each child who turns in a reading log on Friday will have their name put into a drawing for a Notable Reader yard sign.
